

1 3x3 players grid5 red cubes5 blue cones

# Suggested Supplies

Printer and cardstock paper Scissors to cut out each cube and cone Pens and scrap paper, if desired


### How to Play

- 1. Challenge a friend or family member to play.
- 2. Print out the red cubes and blue cones along with the player grid.
- 3. Cut out each cube and cone, and decide which player gets cubes and which player gets cones.
- 4. Decide who goes first—cubes or cones—and agree on the number of games you'll play.
- 5. Take turns by placing a cube or cone in one of the open spaces on the grid.
- 6. Keep an eye on your opponent and block them from getting more than two in a row.
- 7. Make three cubes or cones in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally to win the game.
- 8. The game is considered a tie if all open squares are filled and neither player has three in a row.
- 9. Keep score for each game to determine who is the ultimate winner!

### Alternate Idea

- 1. Print out player grids for the number of games you'd like to play or draw your own grids on scraps of paper.
